**Final Forms:** We are once again using "Final Forms." If you have not already done so, please log on and update your forms. This is for all students whether learning from home or in school. Also, those students who attend LCJVS and LCCC must have these forms completed as well.

**Parking Procedures for PARENTS:** Please note that numbered parking spaces are for staff & students. There is **NO PARKING** in handicapped spaces (without a permit), the fire lanes or along the sidewalk along the west side of the High School (by main entrance).

**Parking Procedures for STUDENTS:** All students who wish to park at CHS must adhere to our rules and register their vehicle. This includes those students who attend the Lorain County JVS. All students are required to have their driver's license, car information and plate number when registering for their pass. Parking passes are \$5.00 for this school year. Seniors can begin to purchase their pass on Wednesday, August 26<sup>th</sup>. Underclassmen can purchase theirs beginning Friday, August 28<sup>th</sup>. Hang tags must be hung on rearview mirrors and visible at all times. Students shall park ONLY in their designated spot and may not park in any other area. Failure to do so could result in the suspension of your parking pass.

<u>Dress Code:</u> All students must wear face coverings while in school. Students are to follow the dress code policy in the Student Handbook. Students who are in violation of the dress code will be sent to the office to call home for a change of clothes. No yoga pants, leggings, pajama bottoms or soft soled slippers of any kind will be permitted to be worn during the school day. Also no pants with rips, shreds or holes are allowed.

<u>Freshmen & New Student Orientation:</u> Tuesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> from 4:30 pm - 6:00 pm. The student may bring <u>ONE</u> parent or guardian with them. Please contact the High School Guidance Office if you have any questions regarding this process. Again, this Orientation is for Freshmen and New Students <u>ONLY</u>. Students will be scheduled according to their last names. More information to follow.

<u>Cell Phones and Electronic Devices:</u> With the increased use of cell phones in society, students may bring these devices to school, but must turn them off during class time. Students may access their phone during class changes and lunch to check messages. Taking pictures, recording video or any action that would cause a violation of the technology agreement are prohibited. Cell phones and other electronic devices are brought into the school at the student's own risk.

<u>Senior & Junior Release</u>: Has been suspended at this time. The only exception will be those Juniors and Seniors that are <u>done for the day</u>.

<u>Announcements:</u> Our daily announcements are posted on the school's webpage, throughout the school and emailed to all students, including those who attend LCCC, LCJVS or are on Virtual Learning.
